Caro's research on Baltimore's inner suburbs also found that the city's black population had done the best in economic recovery, although, again, a large part of the improvement was credited to factors that had nothing to do with the city's economy. While the city overall had made progress in various aspects of life — especially the public sector and public housing — it lagged in providing the "basic necessities" like streets, sidewalks, public libraries, and recreation centers, she found. A number of suggestions from the report were adopted or implemented with subsequent policy actions, including the sale of city assets and infill development projects, which could help address urban blight issues. A more recent study by Caro and Rutgers professor Kenji Yoshino looked at the city's progress in urban renewal and how it was changing social dynamics, with particular attention given to the displaced residents who were being moved out of public housing and elsewhere into the largely white suburbs and other parts of the city. Residents were surprised and upset by how long it took for community input to be considered or taken into account, and that there were so many years of planning before the demolition that made way for a new shopping center. Caro's work on the disurbanization of Baltimore came out about the time her and Yoshino's study was released.
